

Temiskaming Thunder Rep Basketball Program

What to Expect as a Thunder Rep Athlete

The Temiskaming Thunder Rep Program is our competitive travel basketball stream designed for athletes ready to elevate their game. Separate from our Youth League and training clinics, Rep requires greater commitment, but offers even greater reward—on and off the court.

Here's what families need to know:

Program Structure & Time Commitment

- Weekly practices (up to 2) begin in late November and run through May. Some of the boy's rep teams may begin later, in January or February with some skills sessions leading up.
- Rosters can include up to 15 athletes per team.
- **2-4 tournaments** will be scheduled between January-May, primarily in Southern Ontario. Boys' season games typically begin in March.
- **Female teams** also participate in the **New Liskeard Ladies League**, which provides a weekly game (this is age-dependent as well). During that league's season, female teams typically practice once per week. Once it concludes, we ramp up to 2 weekly practices.
- Boys teams, we may consider entering them into the **Thunder Men's Basketball League**, depending on the age level and overall commitment of our players.
- Teams will also compete in at least 8 matchups against OBA teams, including clubs from Northern Ontario such as Timmins, Sudbury, North Bay, and Kirkland Lake (if available in corresponding age groups).
- Open tryouts will be held in **Fall 2025**. Please note that completing the interest form does **not quarantee** a **roster spot**.
- Once we've gathered enough interest through the Rep Team form and connected with our
 volunteer coaching staff to determine which teams we'll run and who will be coaching each
 group, we'll share the official tryout schedule in late August early Sept—including dates,
 times, and locations.
- Each team will have a minimum of 2–3 dedicated Thunder coaches.

We proudly operate out of **two communities**, **New Liskeard** (TDSS/ESCSM) and **Englehart** (EHS). We understand that travel in Northern Ontario can be challenging, and we do our best to minimize travel time and provide **equal opportunity for players and families** across the Temiskaming Shores and Surrounding Areas.



Cost & What's Included

The registration fee ranges from **\$625-\$700 per athlete**, depending on the team. This fee covers:

- OBA registration fees
- Team insurance and program costs, including coach certifications and referee fees
- Tournament entry fees
- Two high-quality game uniforms (to be returned at season end)
- A Thunder Swag Kit for players to keep

Additional Expenses

Families should plan for travel-related costs such as gas, accommodations, and meals during away tournaments. Please note: our program does not provide busing, transportation to and from games and tournaments is the responsibility of families. Our coaching team will share details as early as possible to support budgeting and planning.
